## I. OVERVIEW

Do you want to upload files to e-storage conveniently through email? Or do you want to receive huge files from others and store to your e-storage via email easily?

**Email to e-storage** allows you to accept files from anyone with email.

The sender may just forward email attachments or send files to your temporary e-storage mail-in address at [xxxxx@in.estorage.com.my](mailto:xxxxx@in.estorage.com.my), and the file will just appear at your Private folder— like magic.

To access Email to e-storage, go to **Settings** -> **Email to e-storage**.

## II. GET STARTED

To enable Email to e-storage, check the “**Enable email-to-store**” option.

A temporary mail-in address is ready for you to use. You may change the email address as long as it is unique.

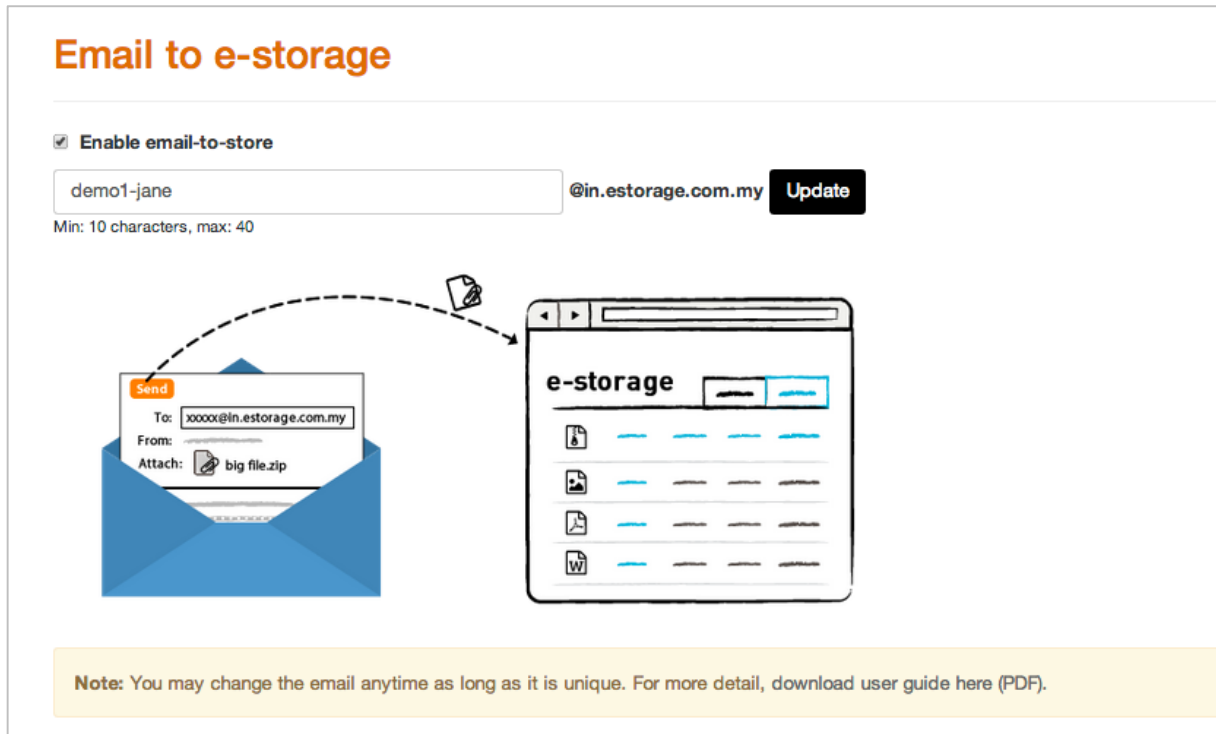


Figure 2. Enabling and configuring Email to e-storage mail-in address

Now, you can distribute this mail-in address to your senders to share and send you files via email, or you can use it privately to backup email attachments by forwarding your emails.

*Note:* The mail-in address' name must be at least 10 characters long.

### III. HOW IT WORKS

With the given mail-in address, the senders may send/forward email attachments to you via their webmail, mail client (Ms Outlook, Apple Mail, Mozilla Thunderbird, etc) or even mobile mail client (iPhone, iPad, Android phones etc) anytime, anywhere.

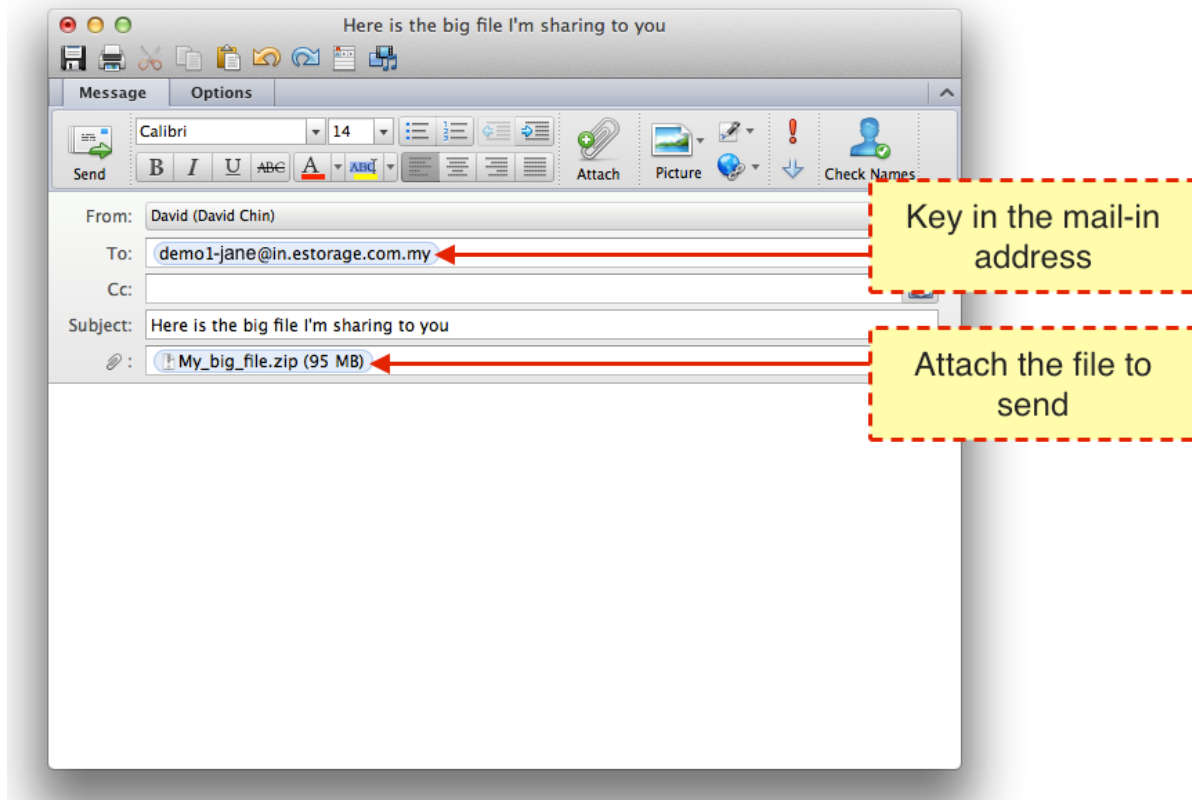


Figure 3. Example of sender sending an email attachment to you

You will receive the attachments directly in your Private > Incoming Email Attachments folder. How easy is that!

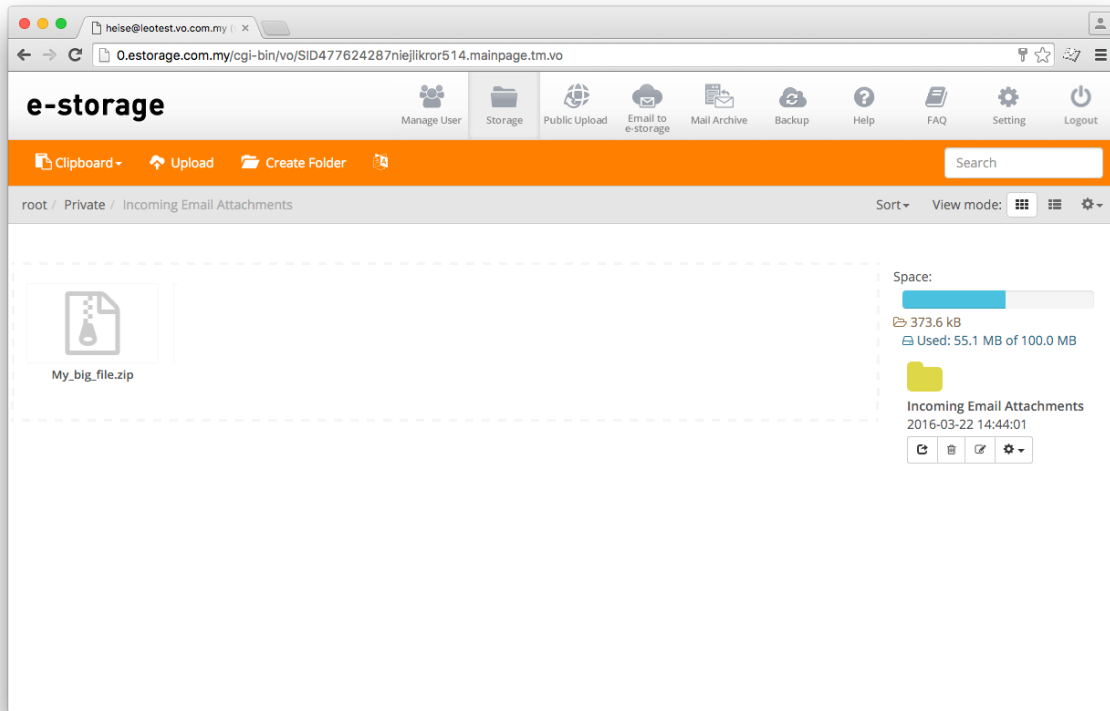


Figure 4. Receiving the attachment in Private/Incoming Email Attachments folder

## IV. FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)

**Q: Is there any attachment size limit to receive files on my e-storage?**

A: The attachment size is limited by your e-storage quota. As long as there is still sufficient space in your storage, you are able to receive the files. You are not able to receive files that have larger size than your available storage size.

**Q: What will happen if I am receiving two files with the same filename? Will the older one be overwritten?**

A: No. Files with the same name will be automatically renamed, not overwrite.

**Q: I am getting spam from the mail-in address. What should I do?**

A: You may change or randomize the mail-in address to prevent spam and ensure that the email address is not being abused.

**Q: Will I receive any emails sent to the mail-in address?**

A: You will only receive the files attached on the email sent to your mail-in address. Email without attachment will be ignored in this case.
